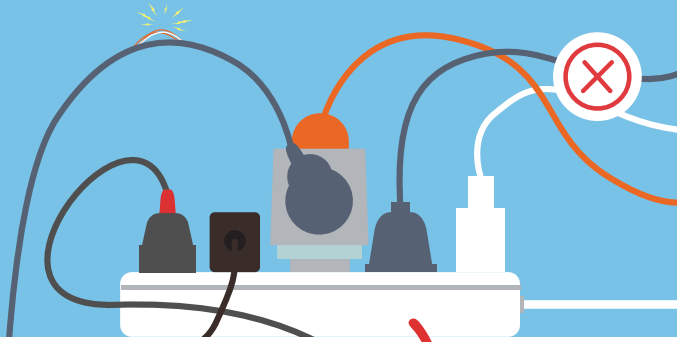


DON'T GO OVERBOARD WITH YOUR POWER CORDS

i Power points and power boards can cause a fire in your home.



There are simple actions you can take to reduce the risk of fire at power outlets.

KEEP CLEAR

Keep power boards **CLEAR** of flammable objects.

SWITCH OFF

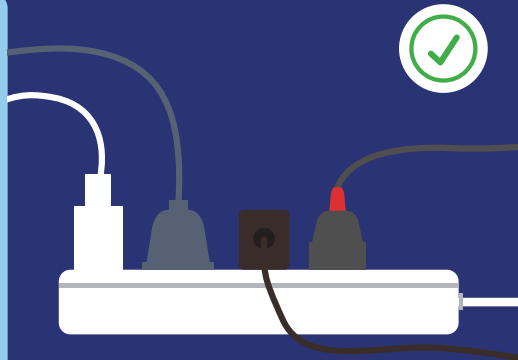
SWITCH OFF power outlets when not in use, and do not overload power boards.

PREPARE

Check power boards for signs of damage or discolouration.

Do not use a damaged power board or extension cord. If faulty, discard immediately.

Provide adequate ventilation around the power boards.
