TYPE:	3 <sup>rd</sup> ge	neration cephalosporin antibiotic [S4]	
PRESENTATION:	1g ceftriaxone powder for reconstitution – vial		
ACTIONS:	<ol> <li>Broad spectrum antibiotic – especially effective against gram-negative bacteria (eg. meningococcus)</li> <li>Effective crossing of blood-brain barrier</li> </ol>		
USE:	ICP	Suspected meningococcal disease, in acutely ill patients	
ADVERSE EFFECTS:	<ol> <li>Hypersensitivity reactions (not common)</li> <li>Diarrhoea</li> <li>Skin rash</li> </ol>		
CONTRA- INDICATION:	Known sensitivity to cephalosporins		
PRECAUTION:	It is possible that 20% patients with a penicillin allergy may be sensitive to ceftriaxone		

## DOSE:

ADULT and PAEDIATRIC:			
	50mg/kg, to a total of 2g – IV preferred.		
ICP	Make up to 10ml with normal saline – give slowly over $2-4$ minutes.	АР	
	May be administered IM – give two injections if dose over 1g (i.e. over 3ml volume)		
ICP	May also be given IO if no IV available

an incident report should be submitted to QSRM if ceftriaxone is administered.
