TYPE:	Unfractioned heparin anticoagulant
PRESENTATION:	5000u heparin in 1 ml – glass ampoule
ACTIONS:	 Inhibits blood clotting Combines with antithrombin III, a naturally occurring anti-clotting factor in plasma, and inhibits the conversion of prothrombin to thrombin It also interferes with the actions of other clotting factors with fibrin stabilising factor
USE:	Patients with an acute ST elevation myocardial infarction who meet the requirements for early percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) procedure
ADVERSE EFFECTS:	 Bleeding Thrombocytopenia Anaphylactoid reactions (rare)
CONTRA- INDICATIONS:	Refer to heparin checklist
PRECAUTION:	Use with care in patients with extensive history of allergies
